Camping & Canoe Trip Gear

Essential For All Campers:

- Sleeping Bag—rated to 30 degrees F; synthetic or down; easy to stuff
 - Rain Jacket—hooded with zip front; more advanced canoe trippers should have rain pants
 - Hiking boots/Trail Shoes—more advanced canoe trippers should have boot with ankle coverage
 - Cooking equipment – small non-stick fry pan, plastic spatula, knife/fork/spoon set, hot mitt, aluminum dinner plate, plastic scrub pads
 - Drinking cup or sealable water bottle
 - Pocket knife—for campers over 10 years of age
 - Life Jacket
 - Hat with brim
 - Water shoe or closed toed sandal
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Essential Equipment for Advanced Canoeists

- Two-four person tent with fly and ground cloth
- Internal frame backpack – with hip, shoulder and torso straps
- 40' – 3/8" lining rope

Recommended Canoe Trip Items

- Sunglasses
- Quick dry t-shirt
- Fleece or wool top
- Quick dry long-sleeve top
- Quick-dry shorts/belt loops
- Quick-dry pants or leggings
- 2 pair smart wool or wool socks
- Wool hat

Hygiene & Personal items

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Comb or hairbrush
- Biodegradable soap
- Sunscreen, SPF 30+
- Insect repellent
- Extra shoe laces

Miscellaneous & Optional items

- Fishing gear-closed face reel
- Waterproof watch
- Disposable camera
- Compression stuff sacks
- Sewing needle/heavy thread
- Small, microfiber towel
- Headlamp or Flashlight/extra batteries
- One gallon –Ziploc bags
- 15 gal garbage bags
- Nylon Stuff sack
- Can opener + knife sharpener
- Sheath knife (not under 10 yrs.)
- Waterproof "river" bags
- Notebook and pen
- Reading material
- Canoe paddle
- Wooden cook spoons
- Spice kits
- Water filtering device
- Compact cook stove
